



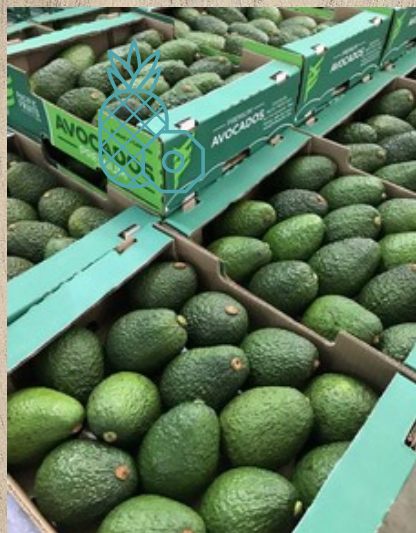
# Fresh Fruit

## Golden Berries



Golden berries are bright, orange-colored fruits that are closely related to the tomatillo. Like tomatillos, they are wrapped in a papery husk called a calyx that must be removed before eating. Slightly smaller than cherry tomatoes, these fruits have a sweet, tropical taste somewhat reminiscent of pineapple and mango.

The Hass avocado is one of the most delicious varieties of avocado around, with a rich creamy flesh and superior taste, with dark green-colored, bumpy skin. It was first grown and sold by Southern California amateur horticulturist Rudolph Hass, who also gave it his name. The Hass avocado is a large-sized fruit weighing 200 to 300 grams

## Tahiti Lemon

This lemon, also known by other common names such as seedless lime, Bearss lime and Tahiti lime, is a citrus fruit species of hybrid origin, known only in cultivation. This lime is a triploid cross between key lime and lemon. Flesh color pale greenish-yellow; tender, juicy; very acid and with true lime flavor.
